## INSTRUCTIONS

- Load the bra prop/s (Conforming Bra and/or Posable Bra) into the scene with G9 selected.





For the scenes where the bra is closed, it is easier to use the Conforming Bra, and the Posable Bra is ideal for all the other scenes where the cups are moved down or opened.

Because of this, the best way is to load both props on the same figure, and just switch on/off the visibility of one or another. In this case, make sure you are using the same material on both props.

Use the sliders for faster posing of the Posable Bra cups (Parameters/General), these sliders will move/rotate all the bones of one cup simultaneously.

You can also pose the Posable Bra cups with movement/rotation/scale of the bones:

Cup L, Cup L top, Cup L 1, Cup L 2 and Cup R, Cup R top, Cup R 1, Cup R 2.

Posable Bra cups will follow the figure to some extent but will need manual adjustments if they are closed on a posed figure, they will also follow the scale of the Pectoral bones of the figure

(up to 150% scale, after that, may also need manual adjustments, especially if the figure is posed).

Easy posing sliders of the Posable Bra prop:

R Cup Translate Z - Complete right cup Z translate

R Cup Translate Y - Complete right cup Y translate

R Cup Translate X - Complete right cup X translate

R Cup Rotate Z - Complete right cup Z rotate

R Cup Rotate Y - Complete right cup Y rotate (opens/closes the cup)

R Cup Rotate X - Complete right cup X rotate

L Cup Translate Z - Complete left cup Z translate

L Cup Translate Y - Complete left cup Y translate

L Cup Translate X - Complete left cup X translate

L Cup Rotate Z - Complete left cup Z rotate

L Cup Rotate Y - Complete left cup Y rotate (opens/closes the cup)

L Cup Rotate X - Complete left cup X rotate

## **INSTRUCTIONS**


- Load materials with the desired prop selected in the scene.

If you want to load the same material on both props you can select both props in the scene and apply the material to both props with one click.

You can load the desired material on the complete fabric part of the bra or on one or more surfaces of the fabric part.

The fabric parts of both bra props are divided into 5 surface groups:

Back, Cups 1, Cups 2, Cups Bottom, Cups Top.




To apply the desired material to one of the surface groups, click on the icon with that surface group name and the desired material number.

To apply the material on the complete fabric part of the bra, click on the icon with the "FULL" word on it and the desired material number.





If you would like to change the color of the fabric material, select the bra prop, go to the Surfaces tab, select one or more fabric surface groups (Back, Cups 1, Cups 2, Cups Bottom, Cups Top), go to Base/Base Color, and just click on the color and pick a different one.
